To what extent have the outcomes for this result area been achieved?		All planned activities were executed and results achieved. The intervention of UN Women aims at trying to achieve improved access and active participation of Yemeni women in the official peace processes, to influence the dynamics of peace negotiations and to implement gender-specific provisions in all conflict, peacebuilding and reconstruction processes. UNWomen had and continues to have a strategic partnership with the Office of the Special Envoy and with other Track II stakeholders to feed into the peace process and work towards full participation of women at consultations and peace talks. The impact of the intervention will be assessed in the final report. As no actual peace talks were held during the reporting period and the conflict ongoing the established Yemeni Women's Pact continued to strengthened through this UNWomen's project (YWP was established with the assistance of UNWomen).

Reasons for result achieved:		Yemen Women's Pact was established, capacity strengthening process took place/started, linkin to stakeholders such as the UN Envoy started, participation of 30% women to peace talks not yet established due to the fact that peace talks have not yet started.			
Implications for planning:		As the Yemen conflict is ongoing and the UN-led process did not lead to actual peace talks/consultations during the reporting period focus has been on strengthening YWP. The project had a late start, therefore a four month no cost extension was requested and granted: the final reporting will include the period September 2017 - December 2018. It has been a challenge for UNWomen/YWP to apply for permits to conduct events and meetings in Yemen. This is an issue that has impacted all UN agencies, international and increasingly local NGOs. Under the leadership of the Resident Coordinator and the Humanitarian Country team efforts are being made to address this challenge. Furthermore, local staff has encountered some challenges with local authorities, a variety of measures have been taken to address local staff's vulnerabilities to pressure including working with the UN Country Team and seeking high-level intervention from influential actors. These steps have resulted in an easing of pressure and a facilitation of operational and programmatic efforts.
